KARAKUŞ TUMULUS (MONUMENT GRAVE) (I.Century B.C.)

The tumulus construction is a memorial grave of Commagene Royal Family; its upper surface is formed with broken stones and there are columns around it. There is an eagle on the southern column, a lion and a bull on the eastern column, a relief showing King Mithridates II. Shaking hands with his sister Laodike. According to the inscription on the eastern column, this grave belongs to mother of Mithridates II (B.C.36-20) Isias, his sister Antiochis and his niece Aka.

THE HOPSCOTCH

Hopscotch is a children's game that can be played with several players or alone. Hopscotch is a popular playground game in which players toss a small object into numbered triangles or a pattern of rectangles outlined on the ground and then hop or jump through the spaces to retrieve the object.



◆ Here are definitions of outdoor games we performed in our project.

SPINNING LONG ROPE

A *skipping rope* (British English) or *jump rope* (American English) is a tool used in the sport of skipping/jump rope where one or more participants jump over a rope swung so that it passes under their feet and over their heads. There are multiple subsets of skipping/jump rope including: single freestyle, single speed, pairs, three person speed (*double dutch*), and three person freestyle (*double dutch freestyle*). The events are often separated by sex and age. There are hundreds of competitive teams all around the world. There are a few major organisations that support jump rope as a sport as seen below.



SPINNING TOP

A *spinning top* is a toy designed to spin rapidly on the ground, the motion of which causes it to remain precisely balanced on its tip due to its rotational inertia. Such toys have existed since antiquity. Traditionally tops were constructed of wood, sometimes with an iron tip, and would be set in motion by aid of a string or rope coiled around its axis which, when pulled quickly, caused a rapid unwinding that would set the top in motion. Today they are often built of plastic, and modern materials and manufacturing processes allow tops to be constructed with such precise balance that they can be set in motion by a simple twist of the fingers and twirl of the wrist without need for string or rope.
